CALL FOR STORIES!

Fourth Edition of the Big Book Alcohólicos Anónimos In keeping with the recommendation of the 2021 General Service Conference that "A Fourth Edition of the Spanish-language Big Book, *Alcohólicos Anónimos*, be developed, including updated stories that better reflect the current membership, and that a progress report be presented to the 2022 General Service Conference," the trustees' Literature Committee is seeking stories of recovery from members of the Hispanic community in the A.A. structure in the United States and Canada.

Armed Forces Interview Project The Trustees' Committee on Cooperation with the Professional Community/Treatment and Accessibilities is seeking A.A. members in the U.S. and Canadian Armed Forces to discuss their experience, strength and hope as sober members of A.A. in the military in recorded anonymity-protected interviews. The goal of this effort is to improve A.A. outreach to members in the U.S. and Canadian military.

"Inside Sponsorship" The trustees' Committee on Corrections is requesting shared experience on the methods by which A.A. members on the outside sponsor members inside correctional facilities. This request is to address an unmet need for sponsorship of A.A. members in custody. Once compiled, this can be added to corrections service material.

"A.A. for the Black and African-American Alcoholic" Pamphlet Update The trustees' Literature Committee has opened a call for recovery stories in response to the 2021 General Service Conference advisory action regarding the pamphlet "A.A. for the Black and African American Alcoholic," stating that the pamphlet be updated to include current stories of recovery and a new title that is respectful and inclusive. The committee is seeking stories of recovery from all African American, Canadian, Caribbean A.A. members from the English, French and Spanish-speaking Black communities in the A.A. structure in the United States and Canada.

For the Fifth Edition of the Big Book An update of stories to better reflect the current membership, keeping in mind the 1996 Advisory Action: "The first 164 pages of the Big Book, *Alcohólicos Anónimos*, the Preface, the Foreword, 'The Doctor's Opinion', 'Dr. Bob's Nightmare', and the Appendices remain as is." In response to the 2021 General Service Conference Advisory Action requesting the development of a Fifth edition of the book *Alcohólicos Anónimos*, the trustees' Literature Committee is seeking a wide range of A.A. recovery experience of members in the Fellowship. The trustees' Literature Committee is searching for recovery stories of our members for possible inclusion in the Fifth Edition which are from a broad cross-section of our local communities; all stories are of value. As Bill writes on page 29 of the book *Alcohólicos Anónimos*: "Our hope is that many alcoholic men and women, desperately in need, will see these pages, and we believe that it is only by fully disclosing ourselves and our problems that they will be persuaded to say, 'Yes, I am one of them too; I must have this thing.'" It is the Literature Committee's shared hope that any new stories from our current membership will help future alcoholics to identify and find recovery in the pages of a Fifth edition.

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AA's Twelve Steps are principles for personal recovery. The Twelve Traditions ensure the unity of the Fellowship. The Twelve Concepts for World Service provide a group of related principles to help ensure that various elements of AA's service structure remain *responsive* and *responsible* to those they serve. **Step Six:** "Were entirely ready to have God remove all these defects of character." **Tradition Six:** "An A.A. group ought never endorse, finance or lend the A.A. name to any related facility or outside enterprise, lest problems of money, property and prestige divert us from our primary purpose." **Concept Six:** "On behalf of A.A. as a whole, our General Service Conference has the principal responsibility for the maintenance of our world services, and it traditionally has the final decision respecting large matters of general policy and finance. But the Conference also recognizes that the chief initiative and the native responsibility in most of these matters should be exercised primarily by the trustee members of the Conference when they act among themselves as the General Service Board of Alcoholics Anonymous."
