The Twelve Concepts for World Service provide a group of related principles to help ensure that various elements of A.A.'s service structure remain responsive and responsible to those they serve. **Step Seven:** "Humbly asked Him to remove our shortcomings" **Tradition Seven:** "Every A.A. group ought to be fully selfsupporting, declining outside contributions." **Concept Seven:** "The Conference recognizes that the Charter and the Bylaws of the General Service Board are legal instruments: that the trustees are thereby fully empowered to manage and conduct all of the world service affairs of Alcoholics Anonymous."
