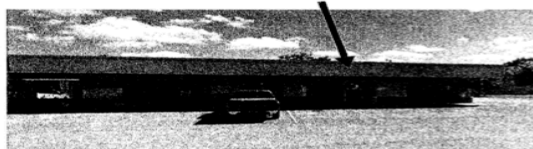

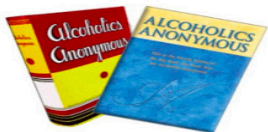

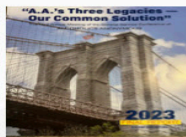

AA's Twelve Steps are principles for personal recovery. The Twelve Traditions ensure the unity of the Fellowship. The Twelve Concepts for World Service provide a group of related principles to help ensure that various elements of A.A.'s service structure remain responsive and responsible to those they serve. **Step One:** "We admitted we were powerless over alcohol - that our lives had become unmanageable." **Tradition One:** "Our common welfare should come first; personal recovery depends upon A.A. unity." **Concept One:** "The final responsibility and the ultimate authority for A.A. World services should always reside in the collective conscience of our whole Fellowship."
