Bridging the Gap is a program working through Alcoholics Anonymous that is designed to connect people leaving a recovery or correctional facility with the A.A. program. When a person leaves one of those facilities and wants help, they can reach out to Bridging the Gap. Bridging the Gap will connect them with a volunteer in their district who will personally reach out to them and help get them acquainted with both A.A. and the meetings in their area. The person asking for help will be matched with a volunteer of the same gender. If you're interested in joining Bridging the Gap as a volunteer, scan the QR code below and fill out the form. We require volunteers to have one year of sobriety to be eligible.

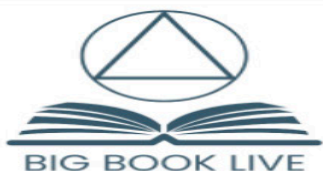

The Twelve Concepts for World Service provide a group of related principles to help ensure that various elements of A.A.'s service structure remain responsive and responsible to those they serve. **Step One:** "We admitted we were powerless over alcohol that our lives had become unmanageable." **Tradition One:** "Our common welfare should come first; personal recovery depends upon A.A. unity." **Concept One:** "The final responsibility and the ultimate authority for A.A. World services should always reside in the collective conscience of our whole Fellowship."
