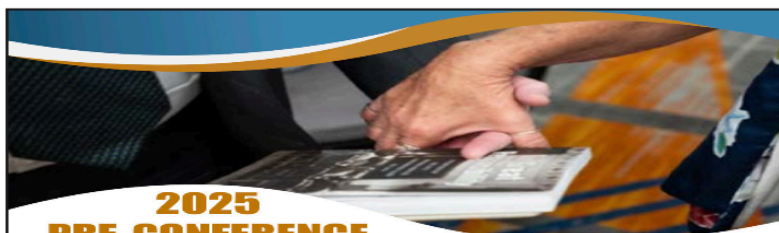

Three Legacies

AA's Twelve Steps are principles for personal recovery. **The Twelve Traditions** ensure the unity of the Fellowship. **The Twelve Concepts** for World Service provide a group of related principles to help ensure that various elements of A.A.'s service structure remain responsive and responsible to those they serve. **Step Three:** "Made a decision to turn our will and our lives over to the care of God as we understood Him.." **Tradition Three:** "The only requirement for A.A. membership is a desire to stop drinking." **Concept Three:** "As a traditional means of creating and maintaining a clearly defined working relation between the groups, the Conference, the A.A. General Service Board and its several service corporations, staffs, committees, and executives, and of thus insuring their effective leadership, it is here suggested that we endow each of these elements of world service with a traditional "Right of Decision."
