AA's Twelve Steps are principles for personal recovery. **The Twelve Traditions** ensure the unity of the Fellowship. The Twelve Concepts for World Service provide a group of related principles to help ensure that various elements of A.A.'s service structure remain responsive and responsible to those they serve. **Step Nine:** "Made direct amends to such people wherever possible, except when to do so would injure them or others.."
Tradition Nine: "A.A., as such, ought never be organized; but we may create service boards or committees directly responsible to those they serve." **Concept Nine:** "Good service leaders, together with sound and appropriate methods of choosing them, are at all levels indispensable for our future functioning and safety. The primary world service leadership once exercised by the founders of A.A. must necessarily be assumed by the trustees of the General Service Board of Alcoholics Anonymous."
