The Twelve Concepts for World Service provide a group of related principles to help ensure that various elements of AA's service structure remain responsive and responsible to those they serve .

**Step Two:** "Came to believe that a power greater than ourselves could restore us to sanity."

**Tradition Two:** "For our group purpose there is but one ultimate authority—a loving God as He may express Himself in our group conscience. Our leaders are but trusted servants; they do not govern."

**Concept Two:** "The General Service Conference of A.A. has become, for nearly every practical purpose, the active voice and the effective conscience of our whole society in its world affairs."
